Temporary Meade By-Pass Roadway Richmond, California

Evaluation of Pre-Construction Conditions in Soil Planned Starting July, 2009

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will oversee the testing of soil at this property as part of an Evaluation of Pre-Construction Conditions in Soil beneath the proposed location of the temporary Meade By-Pass Roadway in Richmond, California (see attached site map). The work is being conducted on behalf of the Richmond Community Redevelopment Agency. Previous soil testing at the site identified low levels of PCBs in shallow soil samples. A drill rig will be utilized to collect soil samples at this site. The work is anticipated to be completed in one to two days, and is described in a work plan dated June 22, 2009 and approved by DTSC.

The following actions will be implemented during this process to ensure public safety and minimize dust:

- Driving vehicles at slow speeds while on the property
- Spraying of work areas with clean water to control dust
- Monitoring the air at the site to ensure the amount of dust stays at safe levels. If dust exceeds screening levels due to sampling activities or wind speeds exceed 25 mph, work will be temporarily stopped

Work hours are 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.
