### Notice of Groundwater Investigation Activities Starting June 20, 2011

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will oversee additional groundwater sampling in Lot 3 of the Zeneca property. Lot 3 is located on the western side of the site near the University of California – Berkeley, Richmond Field Station property boundary.

Additional groundwater data is needed to fully define the amount of volatile organic compound contamination exists in the groundwater beneath the Zeneca property. The groundwater data will be obtained by collected grab-groundwater samples from existing wells in the Lot 3 area. If necessary, additional sampling activities may occur in late summer 2011.

All work will be completed by trained personnel in accordance with applicable State laws.

Work hours are 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.
