## Five-Year Review

The California State Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will be conducting a Five-Year Review at The University of California, Richmond Field Station located at 1301 South 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Richmond, California, 94804. The Site is approximately 82.5 acres consisting of upland areas used for research and educational purposes. The Site is located south of I-580; north of San Francisco Bay; and east of the Marina Bay development.

The purpose of a Five-Year Review is to determine if the current remedy continues to be protective of human health and the environment. If a remedy is found to no longer be protective, DTSC will recommend actions to correct any deficiencies as part of the review. This Five-Year Review is being conducted to meet the statutory requirements under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), § 121 (c)

## SITE HISTORY AND REMEDY

Investigations at the Site indicated Site Soils contained elevated concentrations of arsenic, mercury, lead, polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons and dioxins. Groundwater at the Site contains carbon tetrachloride (PAHs) and trichloroethylene (TCE). Cleanup of the Site began under oversight of the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Control Board in 2002, and DTSC oversight began in 2005. The remedies at the Site included soil excavation following a soil management plan for future construction activities and monitoring of groundwater.
