The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the Final Current Conditions Report for the University of California, Richmond Field Station site located at 1301 South 46<sup>th</sup> Street in Richmond, California. DTSC has reviewed the report which contains revisions based on comments previously provided by DTSC. Based on our review, the report is approved.

Pursuant to Section 5.3 of the Site Investigation and Remediation Order (Docket No. I/SE-RAO 06/07-004) DTSC is requesting that the Respondents prepare and submit for review and approval a Field Sampling Workplan (FSW) within 60 days. The FSW should consist of an overall site investigation strategy and schedule, Quality Assurance Project Plan, and Health and Safety Plan. Individual Field Sampling Plans may be subsequently submitted based on the overall investigation strategy and schedule provided in the FSW. Please note that if new information pertinent to this site is provided to DTSC, this information should be incorporated into the Field Sampling Plans.
