The Department of Toxic Substances Control has reviewed the letter entitled *Proposed Continued Groundwater Monitoring Locations, University of California, Berkeley, Richmond Field Station, Richmond, California* (Letter). The March 25, 2011 Letter was prepared by Tetra Tech EM Inc. for the University of California (UC). The Letter proposes to sample 50 shallow water-bearing zone piezometers that are located at the Richmond Field Station (RFS). Three of the piezometers to be sampled were installed by Zeneca on the RFS property and the others were installed by UC. Based on our review of the sampling and analysis proposed in the Letter, the work is approved for implementation.
