The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the *Technical Memorandum for Well Closures* (Tech Memo). The January 20 Tech Memo was prepared by Tetra Tech EM Inc. (Tetra Tech) for the University of California, Berkeley, Richmond Field Station located in Richmond, California.
