Please find enclosed the Final "For Bid" Corporation Yard Soil Removal Action Construction Drawings and Specifications, Richmond Field Station Site, dated June 26, 2015. The design package also includes the PCB removal action at Building 150. The design package was stamped by the responsible California Professional Engineer on June 30, 2015. California State Fire Marshal approval of construction project designs was also provided by the UC Berkeley Campus Fire Marshal's office and their comments and approval are also included and visible in the design package. The Fire Marshal approval is dated July 10, 2015.

UC Berkeley conducted the site walk with prequalified emergency response contractors on August 6, 2015 and will receive bids by August 25, 2015. The next step entails selecting the contractor and establishing a work schedule for the contractor submittals and excavation activities.
