The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the revised *Phase V Sampling Results Technical Memorandum Western Stege Marsh*, (Memorandum) for the University of California Berkeley, Richmond Field Station, located at 1301 South 46th Street, Richmond, California. The Memorandum, submitted in August 2018, was prepared by Tetra Tech, Inc. on behalf of the University of California, Berkeley and was revised in response to DTSC's June 2018 comment letter. DTSC has reviewed the revisions and responses. The Memorandum is approved with the following modifications:

- 1. Page 27 of the *.pdf document: Delete the third sentence, "All seven samples exceed...." after the "Nickel" header as the fourth sentence is correct.
- 2. Add to Tables 5 and 9 the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board's antimony screening value of 500 ug/L. The reference to be cited is:
