RICHMOND FIELD STATION MONTHLY SUMMARY REPORT

NOVEMBER 15, 2006

This monthly summary report (MSR) summarizes environmental restoration and order compliance activities conducted on behalf of The Regents of the University of California (UC), Zeneca Inc. and Bayer Cropscience Inc. (collectively, Respondents) at Richmond Field Station since October 13, 2006. This MSR is prepared in accordance with Section 6.3 of the California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) Site Investigation and Remediation Order, Docket No. I/SE-RAO 06/07-004, effective on September 20, 2006. - UC submitted the updated Health and Safety Plan pursuant to 5.3.1c of the Order.
- Respondents submitted a Communication and Coordination Plan pursuant to Section 6.1.1 of the Order.
- UC implemented clapper rail predator trapping as required by the Feral Animal Management Program.
- Respondents provided this MSR, pursuant to Section 6.3 of the Order.
- UC provided a sampling implementation plan to DTSC for surface water monitoring.
