## RICHMOND FIELD STATION MONTHLY SUMMARY REPORT

## **MARCH 14, 2008**

This monthly summary report (MSR) summarizes environmental restoration activities conducted on behalf of The Regents of the University of California (UC) at Richmond Field Station since February 15, 2007. This MSR is prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) Site Investigation and Remediation Order, Docket No. I/SE-RAO 06/07-004, effective on September 20, 2006. The MSR is presented in two sections. Section 1.0, Activities Completed During Reporting Period, describes work conducted during the reporting period, and Section 2.0, Activities Anticipated for Next Reporting Period, identifies activities proposed for the next 30 days.

## 1.0 ACTIVITIES COMPLETED DURING REPORTING PERIOD (SINCE FEBRUARY 15, 2007)

- UC issued the Implementation Summary Report for a Time Critical Removal Action at the Former Forest Products Laboratory Wood Treatment Laboratory (TCRA).
- UC collected soil samples for analysis from a planned research wind turbine installation project site between Buildings 112 and 128 to assure the protection of workers completing installation of tower footings and utilities.
- UC submitted a notification for use of glyphosate herbicide to control invasive weeds in upland restoration plots as part of the Invasive/Exotic Vegetation Management Program.

## 2.0 ACTIVITIES ANTICIPATED DURING NEXT REPORTING PERIOD (NEXT 30 DAYS)

• UC will continue to implement invasive plant control as required by the Invasive/Exotic Vegetation Management Program.
