Dear Mr. Haet:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the revised *Final Phase IV Field Sampling Plan Addendum I* (Addendum) for the University of California Richmond Bay Campus, Former Richmond Field Station Site located at 1301 South 46<sup>th</sup> Street. The Addendum, dated October 28, 2014, was prepared by Tetra Tech Inc. and Cabrera Services on behalf of the University of California and describes exploratory excavation work within an area known as the "Bulb". The work includes pre-excavation assessment surveys (including radiological, geophysical and site monitoring), exploratory excavation procedures to identify the source of a magnetic anomaly, collection of samples, site control measures, and site restoration. DTSC reviewed the Addendum and the response to comments, and found that all comments were adequately addressed. While approval of the Addendum was provided by electronic mail on October 28, 2014, the purpose of this letter is to provide formal written approval of the Addendum and to acknowledge that DTSC has no further comments to the health and safety plan.
