The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the letter response to comments for the Field Sampling Work Plan to conduct additional groundwater investigations within and in the vicinity of the BAPB at the University of California Richmond Field Station, Richmond, California, dated March 8, 2012. The letter was prepared by Terraphase Engineering on behalf of Zeneca Inc. and provides responses to DTSC's February 22, 2012 comment letter. The work plan describes locations and methods for collecting additional ground water samples at the portion of the biologically active permeable barrier (BAPB) that is located on the University of California, Berkeley, Richmond Field Station property.
