The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the *Corporation Yard, Data Gap Sampling Approach* workplan for the University of California Berkeley (UC), Richmond Field Station located at 1301 S. 46th Street, Richmond, California. The workplan, dated July 29, 2019, was prepared by Tetra Tech, Inc. on behalf of UC and proposes additional soil sampling within the Corporation Yard for PCBs. Incremental Sampling Methodology will be used to collect a minimum of 75 soil increments from 17 different decision units. The increments will be collected from the top 2 inches of the native surface. Field triplicates will be collected from two random decision units.

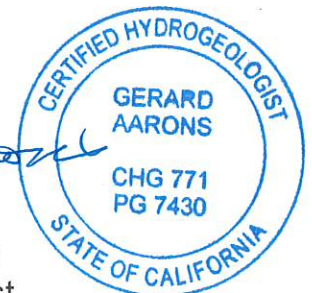
DTSC has reviewed the workplan and has no comments; therefore, the document is approved as submitted provided that any concerns by the US Environmental Protection are addressed.
