What is the work?

Under the oversight of the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), the University of California, Berkeley's environmental consultants will be conducting an environmental investigation within the Western Transition Area (WTA) at the Site. The investigation involves sampling for polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) and defining the lateral extent of a dark petroleum layer identified during a previous investigation. A truck-mounted drill rig will be present along with 1-2 staff from the driller and 2-3 staff from the environmental consultant.

When will you see the work?

- Work will begin **November 1, 2021** and will take approximately five days.
- All work will be completed during normal business hours on weekdays (7:00 AM to 6:00 PM).

Where will you see the work?

- Please see map on the reverse side of this notice.
- The investigation will be focused in the WTA (outlined on the map). There will be no traffic impacts or road closures.

What safety measures will be in place?

Workers will be wearing protective gear and following Contra Costa County's COVID-19 social
distancing requirements. There will be no excavation or off-haul activities during this
investigation. Soil removed from the investigative boreholes will be contained in drums.
