Work is scheduled to begin week of July 6, 2020 and last 2 to 3 weeks

Why This Notice?

Under the oversight of the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), Environmental Consultant Terraphase Engineering Inc. will begin work to support the cleanup activities found in the Lot 1, Lot 2 and Uplands Portion of Lot 3 Feasibility Study/Remedial Action Plan (FS/RAP) approved by DTSC on October 25, 2019.

The Pre-Design Investigation Work Plan, approved by DTSC on May 21, 2020 describes in more detail the work that will be performed. The purpose of the work is to collect groundwater and soil vapor samples to help design the soil vapor extraction system and in-situ groundwater treatment design included in the FS/RAP.

What Work Will Be Done?

- collection of groundwater from monitoring wells;
- collection of grab groundwater samples;
- collection of soil vapor from new and existing soil vapor probes; and
- Soil vapor samples will be analyzed by a mobile laboratory that will be on the property.

All activities will be consistent with the Final Feasibility Study/Remedial Action Plan (FS/RAP), Richmond Bay Campus, Richmond, California, dated October 25, 2019. Workers will be wearing protective gear and following Contra Costa County's COVID-19 social distancing requirements. All work will be completed during normal business hours (7:00 AM to 6:00).
